



**Operating system with unstable fan control management detected. Do you want to deactivate fan sensor readouts?**

You are using an operating system version which might contain a defective component for fan control. Because Hardware Monitor has to communicate with Mac OS X fan control to get fan sensor readings, this could increase the likelihood the operating system crashes with a Kernel Panic.

A Kernel Panic is a situation in which the operating system detects an error in itself. In this situation Mac OS X is halted immediately without saving any data. If you want to avoid the potential risk of losing data it is recommended to deactivate access to fan sensors until you have upgraded to a correctly working version of Mac OS X.

After pressing the "Deactivate" button, the application will switch the preference values for all fan sensors to inactive. The sensor entries remain in all configured output channels, so you won't need to re-insert their preferences later after the problem has been solved.
